TOPICS FOR INTERNAL ASSESSMENT ASSIGNMENTS (2015-16) Course: M.A. ENGLISH (PREVIOUS YEAR)

Note: Students are advised to read the separate enclosed instructions before beginning the writing of assignments.

Out of 20 Internal Assignment marks per paper, 5 marks will be awarded for regularity (attendance) to Counseling/Contact Programme classes pertaining to the paper. Therefore, the topics given below are only for 15 marks each paper.

Note: All Topics are compulsory. Each Topic carries FIVE Marks.

Paper I: Chaucer and the 16th Century

- 1. Analyse and comment on Chaucer's use of imagery in developing the character of the Wife of Bath in <u>The Prologue to the Canterbury Tales.</u>
- 2. Comment on the representation of the aristocratic class in <u>Duchess of Malfi.</u>
- 3. The women characters in the play <u>Hamlet</u> provide a counter paradigm to Hamlet. Elaborate.

Paper II: Seventeenth and Eighteenth Centuries

- 1. Discuss John Donne as a Metaphysical poet.
- 2. Discuss the relationship between Man Friday and Robinson Crusoe.
- 3. Analyze <u>Gulliver's Travels</u> as a comprehensive satire on human nature and society.

Paper III: The Nineteenth Century

- Discuss features of Romantic poetry with reference to the poetry of Keats or Wordsworth.
- 2. Examine the Victorian Sensibility as depicted in <u>Hard Times</u>.
- 3. 'On Liberty' "espouses individualistic spirit of modern societies". Comment on this statement.

Paper IV: Recent Indian writing in English and in English Translation

- 1. Discuss Tradition versus Modernity in Ananthamurthy's Samskara.
- 2. Evaluate Kamala Das as a feminist poet.
- 3. Write a note on the narrative technique in The God of Small Things.
